



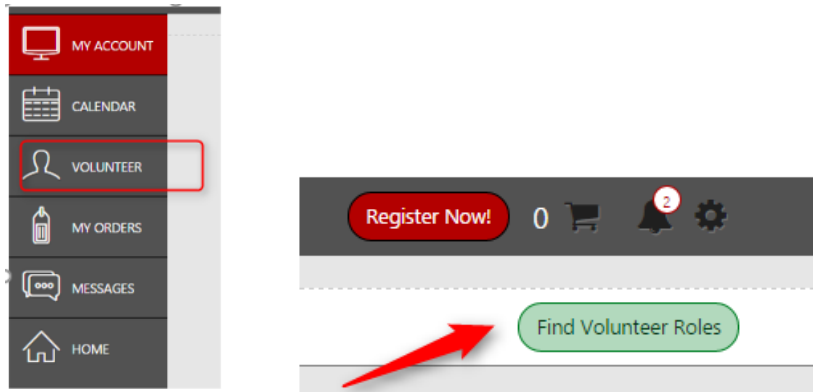
How can I sign up to Volunteer?

You can sign up to volunteer while you are registering your player.

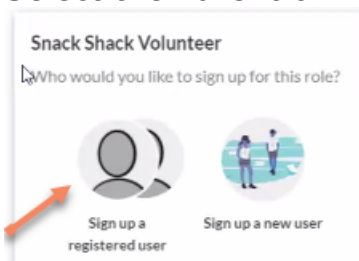
During the registration process, select the appropriate program and role that you would like to sign up for and enter all required information.

If you did not sign up to volunteer while registering your player, you can sign up later.

Log into your account and click on the **Volunteer** tab >>and then click on Find **Volunteer Roles** on the right.



Select the Parent or Invite new account user (click continue)



Select the program, division, and role that you wish to sign up for, hit **Next**, and enter all required information. Once you are a volunteer, the role will display in your account like the image below.



NOTE:

*Middle Name

AYSO Nationals is aware that the Middle Name can not be altered and is not an option to complete when registering. Blue Sombrero and AYSO are working to correct this. To date, we have not found it to be an issue with background checks being completed.

*Current Fall Season (click view roles after selected)

AYSO members who are with a specific Division, such as a Coach or Team Parent needs to register to this program and under the correct division to be allocated to your team. If you are volunteering to be Team Parent for two teams, then you must complete the volunteer registration twice.

*If **BOTH** Parents would like to Volunteer (primary account holder and invited additional account holder), these steps must be done **for each** Volunteer in the same account in order to be allocated to a player's team.

*Volunteer Registration (click view roles after selected)

AYSO members who are not related to specific teams, such as board members and referees, should register to this program to complete their volunteer form and initiate their background check. Reach out to info@ayso157.org for assistance if needed.

Who pays for background check?

AYSO Pacifica Region 157 Board has voted to pay for the Volunteers background checks. If a Volunteer feels so inclined, the option to sponsor all or part of this cost is available. A Volunteer fee is only processed once, even if the Volunteer fulfills multiple roles.

What do I do if I do not receive a Sterling Volunteers email?

- 1 - log into your ayso157.org account
- 2 - Select Volunteer (on left column)
- 3 - Select "Risk Status"
- 4 - Click "Renew & Update"
- 5 - Immediately check your inbox/spam for Sterling Volunteer email (theadvocates@sterlingvolunteers.com) and follow email instruction.
